Paediatric Emergencies Overview

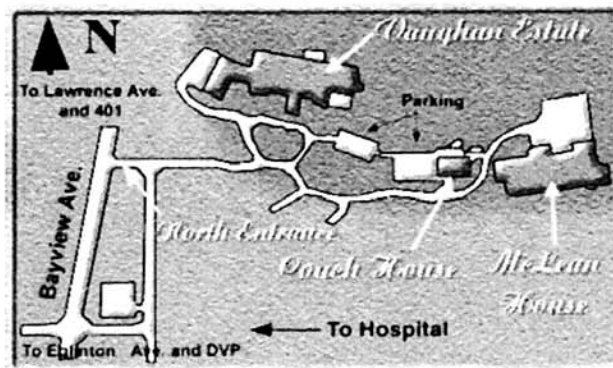
